



Awana at Kentucky Road

Greetings Parents,

When you first hear the word Awana, most people initially think, "You want a what?" Even after I heard about the program, I still had no idea what it was, and I believe that is the case for most people. So what I would like to do in this letter is give a brief introduction to Awana and what we have to offer here at Kentucky Road through this program on Tuesday nights.

Children are the future for this world. And in some cases, their future starts by the time they reach high school. I know that you are concerned about your child and their future. You want your child to be successful in whatever they do. You care about their values, their character, and whether or not they have the right tools to develop a strong moral foundation. But I also know that you are the key person in shaping these things in your child's life. At Kentucky Road, we want to come along side you, the parent, and provide you with tools to grow these foundational things in your child's life. And Awana is the program that we use for children in Preschool-5th grade.

Awana is an international program used in over 22,000 churches weekly in the world. The goal of Awana is to provide a fun and exciting place for both regular attendees of church and non-regular attendees of church to come together, have fun, and learn about the Bible.

This is accomplished in three different parts of the weekly club. First, there are fun and exciting games that allows your child to participate no matter what their skill level is. Second, there is small group time where your child we will receive individualized attention as they work through introductory booklets and age-specific handbooks. Finally, there is an interactive large group segment where children meet together to sing, hear a Bible lesson, and receive awards for their hard work.

At Kentucky Road, we offer this program for the school year for a mere \$30 a student. The reason we do this is because everything we give your child will be theirs to keep. Each year they may receive a uniform, up to two handbooks, and all the awards that they will earn throughout the year. Think about that, \$30 for all these things and for 31 weeks of club interaction, and compare it to the average costs of sporting programs and dance programs offered. It is a longer program and it costs less.

We also are offering this year an opportunity for your child to eat with us before club starts. From 5:00-5:45 on nights before Awana, we will be offering a meal to students in Awana for \$1. This will cover our food costs and it will allow your child to eat before the program starts.

I hope that you will greatly consider being a part of our Awana year this year. We would love to be able to help you equip your child for the future.
